Pain Management in an Older Population

Pain is a common symptom that older individuals frequently experience. Older individuals have a higher incidence of pain yet they receive less pain medications, have their assessed less frequently and suffer the greatest side effects from the medications they receive. Why is this? This session will look at the way our body changes as we age and the effect of these changes on medications. It will use pain control to illustrate the differing susceptibilities of individuals as they age and how we can go about making sure that medications are optimized for our older patients.
